JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: Head Coach – Senior Rugby League

Designation: Head Coach (HC)

Responsible to: Hills District JRLFC & Touch Assoc. Inc.

Primary Objective

To coach the HDJRLFC 'A' Grade Team in all areas both on and off the field.

Provide leadership, advice and direct support to the HDJRLFC Coaches. The Coach will develop individual players for a Team and Club environment as well as prepare these players for the next level of competition.

Key Responsibilities

1. Manage the HDJRLFC Rugby League program, including strategic development and related planning and budgets.
2. Coaching will be primarily team development focused, however some representative level individual coaching may be expected each year.
3. In conjunction with HDJRLFC Committee, promote contemporary coaching practices and advise junior coaches on the skill and fitness requirements to progress players to a higher level.
4. Measure, monitor and evaluate the team performance of HDJRLFC and report on this to the Committee.
5. Assist in the direction and co-ordination of HDJRLFC Rugby League coach education, including the mentoring and training of club coaches.
